Objectives

- Improve the quality and/or quantity of community football club facilities
- Improve the football experience for players, referees, coaches, administrators and spectators
- Provide opportunities for more participants to play more football, more often
- Improve safety at community football facilities
- Promote inclusive football opportunities within Clubs
- Increase security at community football facilities

Opened:	Monday 5 September, 2016
Closes:	Friday 24 February, 2017 at 5pm
Timing:	2 Rounds of the NSW Asian Cup 2015 Legacy Fund
Amount:	\$50,000 to \$150,000 (up to 50% of project)
Who is eligible:	Incorporated clubs, member zones and associations, bodies or other deliverers that are affiliated, recognised and/or sanctioned by FNSW or NNSWF
Who is ineligible:	Football organisations or deliverers who are not affiliated with FNSW or NNSWF, Local Councils, other sports, etc.
DA Approval:	If your project requires a DA, the DA <u>must</u> be approved prior to the grant closing date
Application:	One application per organisation

Eligible Projects

- Upgrade existing pitches
 - Returfing
 - Drainage
 - Irrigation
- Amenities upgrade/renewal
- Synthetic surface
- Floodlighting
- Fencing
- Storage
- Seating

Ineligible Projects

- General maintenance, i.e. painting
- Rent
- Purchase of land
- Purchase of equipment,
 - i.e. computers, uniforms, footballs, etc.
- Administration costs
- Projects that have already commenced or been completed
- Requests for feasibility, design or development stages of projects

Matching Funding

Clubs/Associations/Zones MUST have matching funding

- If you apply for \$100,000 you must have \$100,000 in matching funding

Potential sources of matching funding

- Club funds
- Donations/Voluntary Labour
- Local Government
- Federal Government
- National Stronger Regions Fund
- Private Business Grants e.g. Holden, Telstra, etc.
- Australian Sports Foundation (ASF)
- Other sports
- Other grants schemes
 - Note: cannot double dip into State funding. E.g. Local Sports Grant Program

Assessment Process

February 2017:	Fund closes 24 February 2017
March 2017:	Review by Panel
April 2017:	Decision and notification
May 2017:	Contracting and funding agreements to be signed and returned
June 2017:	Funds allocated and must be acquitted within 2 years
