FACILITY PLANNING



Key aspects:

- Being organised and prepared
- Facilities Plan – linked with association and Council
- Business Case for each project
- Why/Evidence/Statistics

OBJECTIVES



- Improve the quality and/or quantity of community football club facilities
- Improve the football experience for players, referees, coaches, administrators and spectators
- Provide opportunities for more participants to play more football, more often
- Improve safety at community football facilities
- Promote inclusive football opportunities within Clubs
- Increase security at community football facilities

ROUND 1



Update

- Currently CLOSED
- Projects have been assessed
- Currently with the Minister of Sport – Stuart Ayres
- Approximately half of the funding to be allocated in Round 1
- Other half of funds to be allocated in Round 2

ROUND 2



- Opens:** TBC, aiming for September, 2017
- Closes:** TBC, aiming for February, 2018
- Amount:** \$50,000 to \$150,000 (up to 50% of project)
- Who is eligible:** Incorporated clubs, member zones and associations, bodies or other deliverers that are affiliated, recognised and/or sanctioned by FNSW or NNSWF
- Who is ineligible:** Football organisations or deliverers who are not affiliated with FNSW or NNSWF, Local Councils, other sports, etc.
- DA Approval:** If your project requires a DA, the DA **must** be approved prior to the grant closing date.
- Application:** One application per organisation

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS



- Upgrade existing pitches
 - Returfing
 - Drainage
 - Irrigation
- Amenities upgrade/renewal
- Synthetic surface
- Floodlighting
- Fencing
- Storage
- Seating



INELIGIBLE PROJECTS



- General maintenance, i.e. painting
- Rent
- Purchase of land
- Purchase of equipment,
 - i.e. computers, uniforms, footballs, etc.
- Administration costs
- Projects that have already commenced or been completed
- Requests for feasibility, design or development stages of projects

MATCHING FUNDING



Clubs/Associations/Zones MUST have matching funding CONFIRMED

- If you apply for \$100,000 you must have \$100,000 in matching funding

Potential Source of Matching Funding	
Club funds	Stronger Communities Programme (Fed)
Donations	NSW Government Infrastructure Grants
Voluntary Labour	Private Business Grants – Holden/Telstra
Local Government	Australian Sports Foundation
Federal Government	Other Sports

ASSESSMENT PROCESS



- Fund closes
- Review by Panel
- Decision and announcement from Minister for Sport
- Contracting and funding agreements to be signed and returned
- Funds allocated and must be acquitted within 2 years

KEY POINTS



- Football community ONLY
- Meeting the objectives – evidence
- Matching Funding
- Project must be approved
